*Beautifully balanced wine from the foothills of the Pyrenees. Honeyed, opulent and great acidity.*

Catarratto, Nino Barraco, Sicily, Italy, 2016 **9.25/37/53**  
*A warm balance between stone fruit and minerality.*

Malvazija, Marko Fon, Slovenia, 2015 **54**  
*Pure and vibrant with a savoury and herbal note.*

Dominio del Urogallo, Las Yolas, Asturias, Spain, 2016 **60**  
*100% Albillo from old vines. Rich and complex in aromas. Aged nicely in oak. Divine.*

Rkatsiteli, Okro's Wine, Kakheti, Georgia, 2015 – **9/36/50**  
*Made in a qvevri in the traditional Georgian way. Dry and tannic with notes of sherry and apricots.*

Ageno, La Stoppa, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2010 – **10/40/56**  
*This wine is one of Italy's benchmark wines. Rich and nutty with a wonderful texture. We love it.*

Le Coste Bianco, Le Coste di Gradoli, Lazio, Italy, 2013 – **63**  
*A blend of Procanico, Malvasia and Vermentino. This is a spirited and structured wine with a slight spritz at the first drop.*

Vitovska, Paolo Vodopivec, Carso, Italy, 2010 – **12.5/50/75**  
*Pure and profound. This wine is truly special, and made with so much heart and soul.*
