Verdicchio Classico "Gino", Fattoria San Lorenzo, Marche, Italy, 2016 **6.25/30**
Complex, fresh and mineral. A great wine from a true artisan.

Aphros Loureiro, Vinho Verde, Portugal, 2015 **36**
Fantastic Vinho Verde. Biodynamic, dry and clean.

Hamdani Jandali, Cremisan, Bethlehem, Palestine, 2015 **7.25/40**
A blend of two indigenous grape varieties with pineapple on the nose and a long finish. Made by Salesian monks in the hills of Bethlehem.

Melonix VDF, Jo Landron, Loire, France, 2015 **41**
Floral and mineral. No sulphur and no filtration. Lovely.

Vernaccia di San Gimignano, "Tradizionale", Montenedoli, Tuscany, Italy, 2015 **7.5/43**
Vernaccia with lots of character, just like its maker, the formidable Elisabetta Fagioli.

La Distesa, Terre Silvate, Marche, Italy, 2016 **7.75/44**
A pure & characterful Verdicchio with a splash of Trebbiano. This is a savoury, dry and nutty wine for all seasons.

Catarratto, Nino Barraco, Sicily, Italy, 2015 **8.75/48**
A warm balance between stone fruit and minerality

Evidencia de Lapeyre, Lapeyre, Jurançon, France, 2015 **49.5**
Beautifully balanced wine from the foothills of the Pyrenees. Honeyed, opulent and great acidity.

Charme, Jean Pierre Robinot, Loire, France, 2013 **10/56**
Incredible. A beautiful expression of chenin blanc made by a true wine wizard.

The perfect wines for sharing plates.

Ageno, La Stoppa, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2010 – **10/56**
This wine is one of Italy's benchmark wines. Rich and nutty with a wonderful texture. We love it!

Radikon, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, 2015–**11/63**
Elegant, mineral and complex. The finish is long with a robust balance between ripe tropical and tart citrus fruits.

Himmel Auf Erden II Maische Vergoren, Christian Tschida, Burgenland, Austria, 2015 – **75**
Wild and unfiltered wine full of citrus and herbs. Delicate yet powerful.

Zibibbo, Gabrio Bini, Pantelleria Italy, 2014 – **13/76**
A wine like no other from the tiny island of Pantelleria. Herbacious, floral and absolutely wonderful.

Pure cinsault from old vines. An enchanting wine with notes of undergrowth and a chiselled yet light body.
